## Trail Crew Technical Advisor June 20-September 29, 2017 working in Washington

Lead the nation's premier volunteer-based trail crew programs on the spectacular Pacific Crest National Scenic Trail. This is a great career-building opportunity for rising professionals.

In this position you will have the opportunity to:

- Work with youth and volunteer trail crews, support corps crews, teach excellent trail work
- Coordinate and oversee projects on the ground along the Pacific Crest Trail
- Design and layout trail relocations
- Spend time outdoors and on the trail in Goat Rocks and Glacier Peak Wildernesses

The Trail Crew Technical Advisor is a full-time seasonal staff position working on trail projects in Washington for the 2017 work season. Weekly compensation will average \$700-800. Seasonal employees whose originally assigned work schedule is greater than six months may also be eligible for insurance benefits. Dependable personal transportation, a good driving record, and auto insurance is required and mileage is reimbursed.

We are seeking applicants with:

- Minimum of two years of relevant professional experience or five years of substantial volunteer experience
- Experience in training, managing, and leading trail crews
- Backcountry living and Leave No Trace skills
- Excellent organizational skills
- The ability and willingness to travel on the PCT in remote, backcountry locations, often requiring several days of backcountry travel and living
- Trail design and construction experience including GPS tracking skills and maintenance skills
- Proven experience in working with volunteers
- The ability to perform physically demanding trail work
- Excellent written, electronic and verbal communications skills
- Ability to work independently and as a team player
- Good interpersonal and relationship-building skills
- Minimum basic OSHA compliant first aid and CPR certifications, wilderness first aid preferred
- Chain and crosscut saw certification desirable
