ORDER NO. 06-05-18-01  
National Forest System Trails

Pursuant to 16 USC § 551 and 36 CFR § 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited upon the North Fork Sauk Trail No. 649 on the Darrington Ranger District within the Mt. Baker-Snoqualmie National Forest as described below and shown in Exhibit A. This Order will be effective beginning August 8, 2018 and ending August 15, 2018.

PROHIBITION:

1. **Being on the Trail.** [36 CFR § 261.55 (a)]

The Closure Area consists of the North Fork Sauk Trail No. 649 between Mackinaw Shelter and the junction with the Pacific Crest National Scenic Trail No. 2000 in T29N R13E, Sections 1 and 37, T29N R14E, Section 6 and T30N R13E, Section 36.


EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.

Violations of this prohibition is punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor, by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC § 551; 18 USC § 3559 and 18 USC § 3571).
