Inventoried Roadless Areas Along the PCT

■ Inventoried Roadless Areas

The Pacific Crest Trail and other National Scenic and Historic Trails will be heavily affected by the Trump Administration's plans to roll back the 2001 Roadless Rule. The Clinton-era rule protects nearly 58 million acres of undeveloped backcountry forestland managed by the U.S. Forest Service, comprising around a third of the territory in our National Forests.

- The PCT bisects 71 Inventoried Roadless Areas across 3 states
- 231 miles, or 8.7% of the PCT is within USFS Inventoried Roadless Areas
 - California: 162.6 miles
 - Oregon: 15.6 miles
 - Washington: 53.2 miles
